- Chrome, Firefox, Safari.

KEY WCAG SUCCESS CRITERIA

See WCAG 2.0 Guidelines at <www.w3.org/TR/WCAG20/>.

- **1.4.3 Contrast (Minimum):** The visual presentation of text and images of text has a contrast ratio of at least 4:5:1 (Level AA).
- **1.4.4 Resize Text:** Except for captions and images of text, text can be resized without assistive technology up to 200 percent without loss of content or functionality.
- **2.1.1 Keyboard:** All functionality of the content is operable through a keyboard interface without requiring specific timings for individual keystrokes (Level A).
- **2.1.2 No Keyboard Trap:** If keyboard focus can be moved to a component of the page using a keyboard interface, then focus can be moved away from that component using only a keyboard interface. If it requires more than unmodified arrow or tab keys or other standard exit methods, the user is advised of the method for moving focus away (Level A).
- **2.4.7 Focus Visible:** Any keyboard operable user interface has a mode of operation where the keyboard focus indicator is visible (Level AA).
